Background:

Oasis is a passionate and ambitious organisation committed to tackling the causes and consequences of domestic abuse on families. We are known in Kent & Medway for our dedicated, independent services that have been supporting the cause with a local focus for many years.

Overall:

We provide an efficient service for families affected by domestic violence and abuse across Kent & Medway. These families and individuals will have a range of needs, and our client support work is needs-led, risk-focused & trauma-informed with a focus on developing individual resilience. We work with clients in a range of settings. We provide group work, and all support colleagues are expected to be capable of integrated working in the wider social system. Colleagues are expected to work flexibly as needed by service demands, this includes evenings and weekends. Where necessary colleagues are also expected to participate in the out-of-hours service, providing an on-call system for the refuge service users (for which enhancements are paid)

The Team:

The team who run our charity boutique are led by our dedicated shop manager who is supported by a team of amazing volunteers who contribute a collective average of 189 hours (about 1 week

21 hours) a month to support us! The team accept donations, sort and size clothing, steam clean all items, rotate stock to reflect the season, dress mannequins and merchandise the store to ensure our lovely boutique always has that **wow** factor. We also have an online sales function using Vinted. We continue to grow our reach and our customer base to raise much needed funds for our services supporting survivors of Domestic Abuse.

Purpose of the role

The role of Online Sales Volunteer is an exciting opportunity to build your online sales knowledge and expertise. We are looking for someone who could settle into our busy, growing and well-respected organisation and support us by posting high end donated items using online platforms such as Vinted.

You'll have a keen eye for detail and enjoy creating enticing pictures of our high-end donations to encourage people to buy. You'll have excellent customer service skills and good technical skills. You'll be committed to helping us provide the gold standard of customer care, ensuring each item sold is steamed and carefully packaged for posting, with all items dispatched to the purchaser in a timely manner. You will be organised and able to manage online queries and questions from customers as well as confident in the use of Microsoft systems such as Excel which you will use to log each sale.

Key Responsibilities:

- 1. Dealing politely with customers to the online shop.
- 2. Responding to online queries from customers to the online shop.
- 3. Sensitively accepting donations from the public.
- 4. Advertising all suitable stock online in a timely manner.
- 5. Registering each sale accurately.
- 6. Assisting with sorting and sizing donated items
- 7. Steam cleaning items once sale agreed.
- 8. Carefully packaging and posting items in a timely manner.
- 9. Maintaining good health and safety practices.
- 10. Representing Oasis and our values at all times during your shift.
- 11. Creating enticing postings for items using online selling sites.
- 12. Researching donated items, to gather as much information on unusual items before listing them online investigative work required!
