## Home should be a safe place for everyone. Sadly, for thousands across Kent, it isn't.

Each year at Oasis we listen to, support and advocate for over 1,500 adults and 350 children who have been affected by domestic abuse. Our aim is to end violence and abuse & spread the message that Love Shouldn't Hurt.

### We do this by providing:

- advice and support from the start through our helpline;
- a safe place to stay for families fleeing abuse;
- support through the courts;
- mentoring and therapy for those who have suffered trauma;
- assistance and empowerment in building a safe new life.



## Ali's Story

Ali managed to phone the Oasis helpline in the few minutes before her abusive partner returned home. She had been given the number by a mum at school, who was worried about her.

Ali "lived like a prisoner", with no access to money and no ability to go out on her own. She was told when and what to eat, and her partner drugged her food, making her feel disorientated.

The helpline worker told Ali how to check whether her phone had a tracker installed on it - it had.

Oasis got a burner phone to Ali, and helped her to flee with her 2 children to our refuge.
All three are now safe, and starting on the road to recovery.

## How your support makes a difference

While we receive government funding for some aspects of our work, we are wholly reliant on voluntary donations from companies, organisations and individuals to fund our helpline and grow our services for children and young people. We need your help to provide safe places of refuge, counselling and support for survivors.

## Safeguard a child

Your support could ensure children and young people in our community get the help they need and are taught strategies to deal with their trauma.

£1000 would mean we could provide activities for children affected by domestic abuse, rebuilding their confidence and self esteem.

## Help a family start over again

Fleeing abuse doesn't give you time to pack. Those arriving at our refuges often have few belongings with them. They need the essentials - bedding, crockery, towels, toothbrushes, pyjamas, a cuddly toy for a child...

£550 would allow us to provide a 'starter pack' for a family arriving in refuge.

## Provide a lifeline for someone in need

Our Oasis freephone helpline is a vital resource for people trapped in an abusive relationship. In addition to supporting survivors, we give advice and signposting information to professionals, and concerned friends and family.

£700 would cover the cost of 100 calls.

Macknade shared their skills with some of the young people that Oasis mentors. The food store & cafe invited a group to take part in foodie activities including pizza making and gave them a day out they won't forget! Days out are a key part of our mentoring programme for the children and young people we support they get to meet each other and it helps to boost their self-esteem and social and life skills.

Broadstairs Business Club has been supporting Oasis since 2020, donating monthly to support our work. So far they have given over £3,000!



Girlings Solicitors adopted Oasis as their chosen charity for a two-year period. In that time they have organised some fantastic fundraising activities, from a themed quiz night to dragon boat racing. They raised over £9,000 for Oasis!

## Why raise money for Oasis?

£5	could buy a teddy bear for a child who has just arrived at a refuge
£15	could pay for a set of pyjamas and underwear for a child who wasn't able to bring their own
£50	could pay for a specialist counselling session for a child
£75	could pay for a uniform for a child starting over at a new school in a new area to escape abuse
£150	could pay for a cot and mattress for a baby once its mother leaves the refuge
£200	could pay for days out for the children living in a refuge
£400	could pay for the towels, bedding, crockery and food needed to set up a new home for a woman leaving the refuge
£1200	could pay for a 10-week therapeutic programme for a group of children traumatised by domestic abuse in their family home.
